

1: 28 West Park Avenue, LS8 2EB. A relaxing garden surrounding the house, full of variety, with herbaceous borders, wildlife pond, dry garden, white border, greenhouse and water feature.

2: Park Ville, Street Lane, LS8 2EB. BACK to FRONT Former thriving moss patch successfully turned into a kitchen garden at the front; with fruit and veg beds and a herbaceous border.

3: 1 Park Cottages, LS8 2HL, A garden representing plants in the history of medicine, based on an American Indian Medicine Wheel principle - satisfying a personal need for symmetry.

4: Specialist Gardens, Mansion Lane, , LS8 2HL. The award winning Specialist Gardens: The Alhambra Garden, the Largest Room in the House garden, the RHS Chelsea Flower Show Gold Medal winning gardens, showcasing Yorkshire.

5: Ramwood, Mansion Lane, LS8 2HL. Newly-landscaped garden of over an acre, with planting still in development. Features include: a pétanque, grass 'amphitheatre' and a hidden WW2 bomb shelter. Refreshments available.

6: The Covid Memorial Tree, near the Mansion conservatory LS8 2HL. Covid memorial tree planted in memory of those who have passed away during the Covid 19 Pandemic

7: FORP's Friends' Garden and Sensory Garden, LS8 1AE . Created and maintained by the Friends of Roundhay Park. Find out how a neglected park area became a Yorkshire in Bloom award winning garden. A new a sensory garden, created in 2021 including a willow tunnel, a willow den, raised beds, a sweeping path and tactile planting.

8: Flower bed displays opposite the Roundhay Fox and in the Tram park Friends of Roundhay park, LS8 2EP are celebrating the official opening of the parkland to the People of Leeds 150 years ago

9: Raga Allotments, Near LS8 1DB. Meet the gardeners on their plots. There are 140 plots on this site. See if you want to grow your own.

10: North Leeds Bowling Club, LS81JX. Visit the green and gardens and enjoy an opportunity to sample bowling with the help of bowls club members present on the day

11: Highfield, Old Park Road, LS8 1JX. Yorkshire stone meets the 21st century. Kids play area, chickens, a party barn, outdoor pizza oven, compost & nature area (we don't touch it!).



12: Carr Head, Park Avenue, LS8 2JJ. Visit the modern garden evolved from the Victorian gardeners cottage in the walled garden to the Lupton mansion .

13: REAP's Edible Bed, Oakwood Clock, LS8 2FA. This garden was originally designed as part of the Feed Leeds initiative. It demonstrates how to grow a succession of fruit, vegetables and herbs throughout the year.

14: 1a Springwood Road, LS8 2QA. Medium-sized mature garden with shrubs and perennials. Large wildlife pond, greenhouse , shed, pergola , boat hut , raised beds and soft fruit. The garden is planted to encourage wildlife. Plant sale.

15: Greystones, 11 Oakwood Grove, LS8 2PA. Large mature garden. Naturalised woodland; rose pergola walk; variety of planting areas; Japanese dry pond; stumpy and "jungle" with crocodile pond

16: 6 Borrough View, LS8 1LS. Small garden created during the first lockdown with raised beds, pergola and water feature.'

17: Lidgett Lane Allotments, LS8 1HP. See the range of fruit, flowers and vegetables on 100 allotment plots, get the bug for growing your own. Enjoy tea and cakes alfresco (or under cover)

18: 5 Lidgett Park Grove, LS8 1HW. A courtyard at the back, the front a wildlife friendly garden with pond, herbaceous borders and raised beds. Stained glass and sculptures turn up throughout.

19: 69 The Drive , LS8 1JQ. A family garden for humans and wildlife combining old and new with plenty of work in progress to see.

20: 28 North Park Grove, LS8 1JJ. Large open front garden with small sunny back garden. Flowers and food; a patio with lots of pots; sitting areas. A work in progress with 10 years worth of stories - the successes and the failures.

21: The Banana Bed, Near LS8 1EY. REAP have replanted with perennial wildflowers on this banana shaped garden

22: 56 North Park Grove, LS8 1EW. Behind the gates, recycling and upcycling play an important part in this artist's 'secret' garden leading to his studio.

23: St Andrews United Reformed Church, Shaftesbury Avenue, LS8 1DS. A restful space: Designed by students from Leeds Beckett University, following feedback from the church and community and incorporating Christian Symbolism. Always open
